
WALL TILES — CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CLEANING

- GOLEM wall tiles can be cleaned with standard glass cleaners. However, please make sure that you use acid free products.
- To clean your wall tiles please use only **ph-neutral to alkaline cleaners** like [Soda \(by Holste\)](#) in combination with a so-called [magic eraser \(BASF Basotec\)](#). Both can be found in almost any supermarket or drugstore. We do recommend the following cleaning agents by Patina-Fala: [Patina- Fala Marmor- und Natursteinreiniger, säurefrei \(marble and stone cleaner, acid free\)](#) and [Natursteinbadreiniger \(natural stone bath cleaner\)](#). Lime scale can be soaked with an alkaline cleaner and then fully removed with a brush.

ACID SENSITIVITY

- **Glazes containing copper oxide as pigments (greenish and some bluish colours) are acid-sensitive.** Acid-containing cleaning agents such as vinegar, citrus or limescale remover can cause a so-called lustre effect, a similar effect to that of oil in water. This sheen can effect parts or all of the surface and is not reversible. In former times glass and glazes were made of the same components as today, so this effect was already known then. But the efficiency of modern day's cleaners has increased many times over. Today's cleansing agents are expected to remove the most stubborn contaminations most easily, smell good and disinfect pathogens. But we absolutely do not recommend them for our high-quality glazes.
